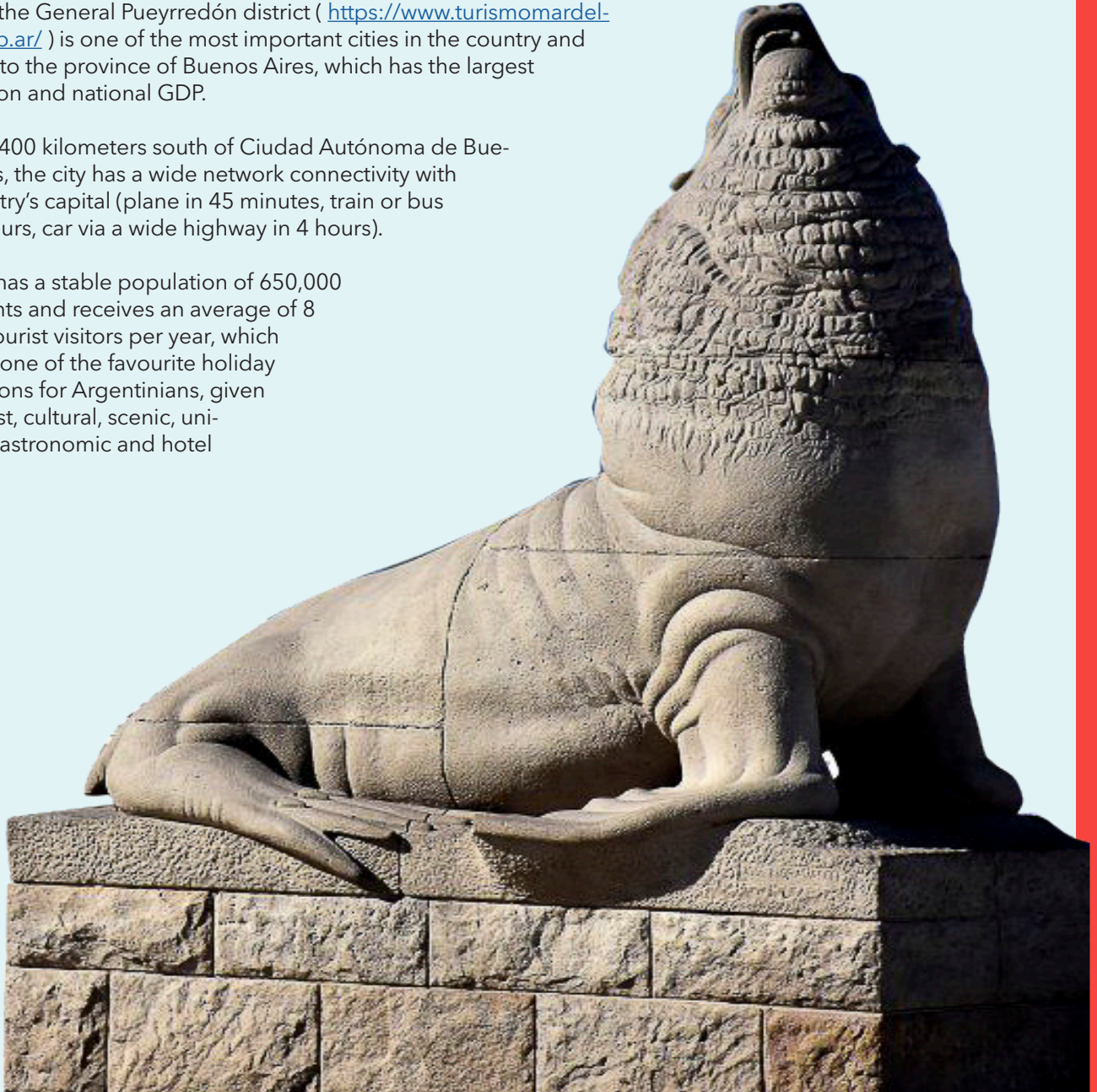
ABOUT MAR DEL PLATA

Founded on February 10, 1874, Mar del Plata is an Argentine seaside resort city on the Atlantic Ocean coast, which has an extensive strip of beaches that includes the most famous and popular resorts in the country.

Head of the General Pueyrredón district (<https://www.turismomardel-plata.gob.ar/>) is one of the most important cities in the country and belongs to the province of Buenos Aires, which has the largest population and national GDP.

Located 400 kilometers south of Ciudad Autónoma de Buenos Aires, the city has a wide network connectivity with the country's capital (plane in 45 minutes, train or bus in 5/6 hours, car via a wide highway in 4 hours).

The city has a stable population of 650,000 inhabitants and receives an average of 8 million tourist visitors per year, which makes it one of the favourite holiday destinations for Argentinians, given the tourist, cultural, scenic, university, gastronomic and hotel offerings

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Geographical Location and Altitude

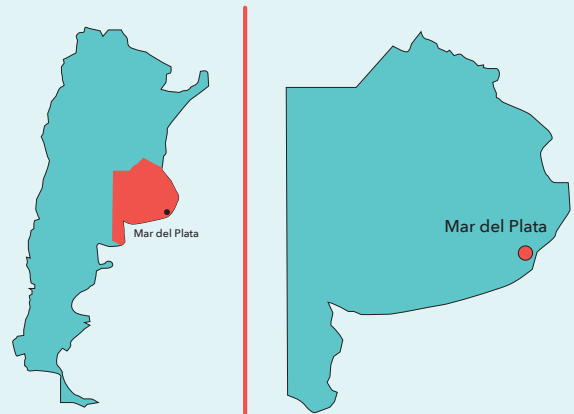
The city's constantly growing structure has a surface area of 79.48 m2. As it is part of the national coastal axis, its altitude is irregular, varying from sector to sector, but the average elevation is 38 meters above sea level.

The city, as mentioned, is located on the South Atlantic coast, coinciding with the following coordinates:

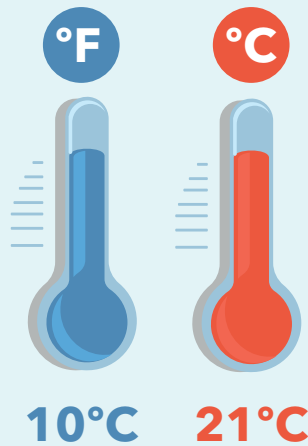

Climate



Pueyrredon District is located in a temperate climate zone with maritime influence.

The average temperature in winter is 12° C to 14° C and in summer it is 23° C to 27° C.

The coldest month is June with an average temperature of 7.7° C and the warmest month is January with an average of 21° C.

Rainfall is regular and throughout the year it predominates in spring and summer.

During the competition period, at the end of April, there is a historical range of temperatures with minimums of 10° C and maximums of around 21° C, cooling considerably at night and with an average rainfall of 8 days during the month.



Sports and Athletics in Mar del Plata



Mar del Plata is a city of reference in sport, not only nationally but internationally.

Local sporting activities are extensive and include both land and water sports, offering sports activities every day and sporting events worth seeing for a large part of the year.

Over the years, due to the attractiveness of the place, various events of international interest have taken place: Davis Cup finals, World,

Pan-American and South American events in different sports, etc.

But without any doubt, what finally positioned Mar del Plata at the pinnacle of world sport was the 1995 Pan American Games. As a result of the joint work of local political and economic forces since the 80s (driven by the former mayor of the city, Mr. Angel Roig), the matrix of local sport changed radically. The world's largest continental event not only provided the city with wonderful sporting events, but also bequeathed it with a world-class sporting infrastructure which is still used today for sporting activities and events.

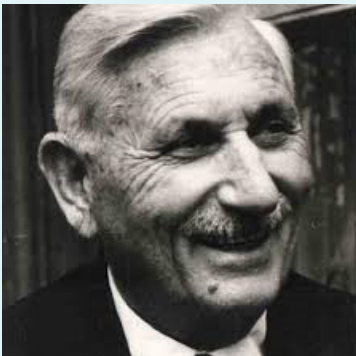


Athletics

Athletics has a prominent place in the city's sporting culture. With a history dating back to the middle of the last century, the city's organized and federative athletics (promoted by historical leaders such as Don Justo Ernesto Román, father of Mar del Plata sport), has a path over the years with countless events of all categories and national and continental champions, as well as Olympic representatives, among which stand out:



Verónica Depaoli , María de los Angeles Peralta (former president of the Athletics Federation of the province of Buenos Aires), Mariano Mastromarino (current president of the Mar del Plata Athletics Federation), Belén Adaluz Casetta and Maria Florencia Borelli (among the latest exponents).



Apart from being the birthplace of great athletes, who are the great protagonists of sport, the city of Mar del Plata had the honour of having great representatives of other levels. Among the leaders, Professor Justo Ernesto Román (father of Mar del Plata sport) and Dr. Jorge Luis De La Canale. Among its international referees and statisticians, Rubén Pedro Aguilera and, and, among the great coaches of our city, Fernando Rodríguez Facal . These were generators, exponents and facilitators of a golden generation of athletic sport in the city.





The city has first-class facilities, such as Justo Ernesto Román Athletic Stadium, home of the aforementioned Pan American Games, where track and field athletics took place. At the same time, as a test event, in 1994 the Ibero-American Athletics Championship was held, while in 1997, the South American Championships were held - both events with unequalled sporting and media results. More recently, in 2024, the first edition of a World Athletics Continental Tour was held in the city, as well as the 24-hour Pan American Track Championship. As if that were not enough, this stadium is the continuous venue for National Championships, Provincial Championships, National Games, Club Cups, Grand Prix series and a great number of local events that feed local athletics every week, making the facilities the most used in the country.

However, due to the prevailing nature of the city, our athletics do not only live off track and field, but also host countless road events (with the Mar del Plata international marathon and half marathon at the top for decades), race walking, cross country and trail races in the surrounding mountains. The coastal and mountainous landscape of our city lends itself to an excellent setting for athletic activity outside the stadium. All of this, throughout the 365 days of the year, brings to the city countless federated and amateur athletes from all over the country and part of the continental region.





International Time

Throughout Argentina, including Mar del Plata, time is governed by the Greenwich meridian.

The applicable time zone is the one internationally established as GMT -3 and does not vary during the year.

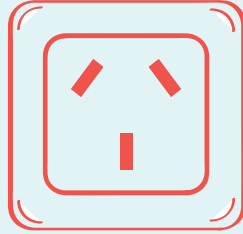
Electricity

The electrical sockets are American type with inputs for two flat pins; the electrical current is 220-240 volts at a frequency of 50 Hz.

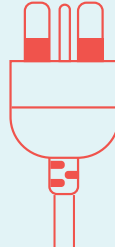

Visa

Most of the countries belonging to Atletismo Sudamericano do not require a visa to enter Argentina. In the case of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, it must be channelled through the corresponding consular authority.

It will be the responsibility of each country to carry out the relevant inquiries/procedures in order to comply with the administrative requirements of all members of their teams based on the country of origin and the regulations applicable to the case at the local and continental level

Communication

The possibility of national and international communication for data, voice and image transmission is extensive in Mar del Plata. Hotels as well as cafés and public spaces offer data connectivity services.

TECHNICAL MANUAL

VENUE



It is the '**Justo Ernesto Román**' Athletic Stadium, located in the Municipal Sports Park in the city of Mar del Plata, which was the venue for the 1995 Pan American Games.



Main Track

It is officially approved by World Athletics as a W.A. Class 2 certified facility and has the following facilities:

- ⇒ 400 meters and eight lanes
- ⇒ 4 pits for long and triple jump.
- ⇒ 2 Shot Put circles.
- ⇒ 1 Cage for Discus & Hammer Throws.
- ⇒ 2 Javelin Throw runways
- ⇒ 3 Pole Vault runways (1 set of mats)
- ⇒ 2 High Jump runways (2 sets of mats)



Warm Up Area

200m. oval track with two complete lanes with hurdles and starting blocks for practice.

Implements

Implements have been officially approved by World Athletics and certified by the Technical Direction of the event.

Medical and emergency services

The venue will be equipped with emergency medical services, including a medical evacuation system

Race Walking

The race walking events for both men and women will be held on a circuit to be defined shortly.



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PARTICIPATION

General Rules

The South American Athletics Championship will be ruled by the Official Rules of World Athletics (WA, hereinafter) and by the Regulations of Atletismo Sudamericano (AS, hereinafter). Unforeseen cases will be resolved by the Technical Delegate and the Competition Director.

Situations not foreseen in in these regulations will be resolved as follows:

- If they are of a general nature: by the Local Organizing Committee.
- If they are of a technical nature: by the Technical Delegate and the internationally appointed referees.



Safeguarding Safeguarding rules

In accordance with the W.A. and A.S. Safeguarding Rules and the recent WA decision at the U-20 World Championships in Lima 2024, AS established that all teams must have a Safeguarding Officer within its official members. 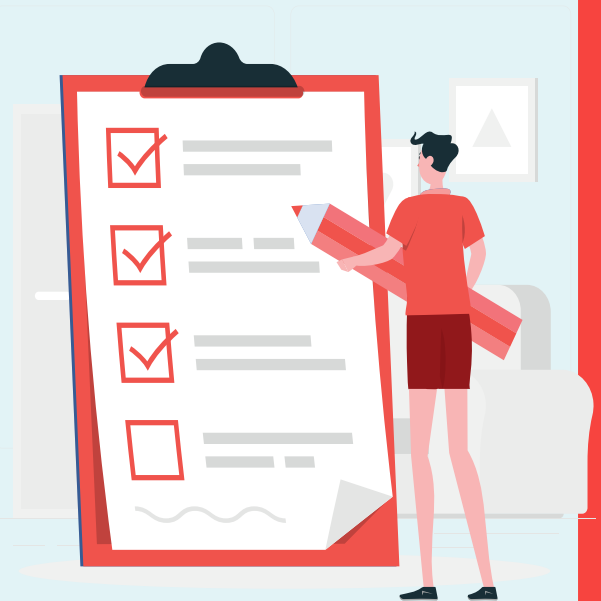
General requirements

Athletes from all countries affiliated to Atletismo Sudamericano and World Athletics, who meet the following requirements, may participate in this event:

- ◆ Be born in the country they represent or be naturalised in the same country.
- ◆ Be within the age limit established by the competition.
- ◆ Be duly registered with the National Federation of his/her country
- ◆ Be duly registered in the competition through his/her National Federation.

Each team must submit the passport of each athlete or any other official document indicating the date of birth as evidence of their age.

For each entered athlete the Local Organising Committee has to photocopy the submitted document as evidence.



Age categories

The event is aimed at senior athletes who must be **16 years of age or older** by December 31, 2025 (born in 2009 or later).

Limitations

- U20 athletes (at least 18 years old on December 31, 2025). No limit regarding the number of events.
- U18 athletes (at least 16 and up to 17 years old on 31 December 2025). They may participate in any event **except** throwing events, combined events, 10,000m and walking events. They can participate in a **maximum** of 3 track events (including relays), of which only 1 can exceed 200m (either in an individual event or in a relay leg).
- U16 athletes (under 16 years old on 31 December 2025) will not be able to participate.



Sex Categories

The matter shall be dealt with according to rule 3.3 to 3.6 of the WA Technical Rules.

Participation limits

- Each country may enter a maximum of two (2) athletes per event and one relay team in each of the relays.
- In addition to these two (2) athletes, the Federations may enter in the South American Championships the athletes classified up to the 5th place in the South American Senior Athletics Ranking of the event in the year of the competition, with a maximum of 15 (fifteen) days before the starting date of the Championships.
- Each athlete may participate in up to three (3) individual events and relays.
- Participants in combined events may only participate in combined events.
- Participating delegations may enter a maximum of 85 athletes, regardless of gender, and 15 officials (managers or coaches).
- Any athlete entered on the nominal list is an automatic substitute for any other athlete in any event.

ENTRIES

PRELIMINARY ENTRY

Preliminary Entry will be made by digital form before 1 March, 2025 at 24:00 hs., according to Buenos Aires time zone (GMT-3).

This preliminary entry must specify the approximate number of athletes and male and female officials in the delegations, in total and per event, informing the expected arrival and departure from the city. They should also indicate, as far as possible, the number of officials present in their country's team.

The technical support area will be attentive to resolve any concerns that may arise during the registration process (administracion@cada-atletismo.com).

FINAL REGISTRATION

Final entries must be made digitally through the Atletismo Sudamericano ADC System by Thursday April 16 2025 at 24:00 hrs. The Technical Support area will be attentive to resolve any concerns that may arise during the registration process (administracion@cada-atletismo.com).

Attached to the Technical Manual you will find a PDF file with instructions for registration.

This final registration must contain the following information:

- List of athletes by name, with their full name and date of birth.
- List of athletes per event, with name, date of birth and best mark of the athlete in the year of competition
- List of officials and coaches.
- Certificate of medical fitness of athletes.
- Health insurance certificate with international coverage for all team members.

Participating Federations may make changes to their team until the Technical Meeting of the competition is held.



CONFIRMATION

The Team Leader or Official Representative must confirm in writing on special forms of the organization the list of athletes registered that will participate in each a of the competencies, **before 12:00 p.m of the day before** the event at the Championships Technical Information Center.

Confirmation for the first day must be made at the relevant Technical Meeting.

Only athletes who are duly registered in the corresponding events at the time and in the forms indicated in the previous point (final registration) will be able to be confirmed.

This is to avoid the inclusion of athletes in qualifying events who, despite being entered, do not participate later.

The withdrawal/confirmation forms will be distributed to the team leaders at the technical meeting.

FAILURE TO PARTICIPATE

In the following cases where:

- Final confirmation has been given that an athlete would participate in an event and then failed to do so ;
- An athlete qualified in any Qualification Round of an event for further participation in that event but then failed to participate further.
- An an athlete failed to compete honestly with bona fide effort (except in individual combined events).

The corresponding referee should apply the provisions of WA Technical Rule 4.4, excluding the athlete from participating in all events in which he/she is entered, including relay events

GENERAL

TECHNICAL INFORMATION CENTER - TIC



Located next to the main entrance of the stadium, near the first curve, it will be the place where delegates must confirm athletes' participation, collect bulletins, results, submit protests, request information about competitions, transport, official communications and competition development and present throwing implements to be checked.

The TIC will operate during the event hours in the athletic stadium area but -at the same time- an official communication system will be established through a dedicated WhatsApp group, where all relevant information will be posted.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR TEAM LEADERS

INTERNATIONAL INSURANCE COVERAGE

As has been resolved by Atletismo Sudamericano, all teams must have international medical insurance coverage for accidents or illnesses during the trip and at the event venue.

Supporting documentation must be submitted to the organisers by **21 April 2025**.

The coverage in question must be for athletes, officials, delegates and accompanying persons of the official delegation of each country.



ARRIVALS

The Organising Committee will provide an information desk at the Official Airport for teams reception and transfer to the accreditation and accommodation sites

STAY

The Organizing Committee will cover accommodation and food expenses from Thursday 24th April until Monday 28th April up to a maximum of 85 athletes and 15 officials according to Atletismo Sudamericano's regulations. Those teams that, due to inconvenient connections, need to bring forward their arrival or postpone departure, must request the express consideration and authorisation of the organising committee

Team leaders should announce well in advance the number of accompanying persons who do not comply with the above to ensure that their accommodation and meals are available. The costs of these additional groups shall be borne by the respective delegations.

Extra days of any person of the delegation (including athletes), which are not within the days established by the organisation, will be cancelled before the accreditations and will be at the financial expense of each delegation.



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Team Assistants

The Organizing Committee will provide teams with a guide service to assist them during their stay in the City.

Participation Numbers - Bibs

Each athlete will receive three (3) numbers which will be distributed at the technical meeting: two (2) for the T-shirt (one on the chest and one on the back), one (1) for the bag.

Only in the jumps athletes will be allowed to wear only one bib number (either on the back or on the chest)

Bibs may not be folded, cut or modified for any reason, in accordance with WA regulations, on pain of disqualification of the athlete.

Athletes participating in running events will be provided with two (2) numbers to be worn on each side of the shorts or pants at the Call Room, before entering the track.



Athletes Uniforms

Athletes must wear the official uniform of their country, which must conform to WA rules. The Awards Ceremony is part of the competition and will be held immediately after the end of each event. Athletes must wear the official uniform of their country during this Ceremony.

For these purposes, team leaders must bring samples of the national team uniform to the technical meeting in order to assess their relevance.



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Official Results

The official results of each event will be announced by the official announcing system in Spanish. The results will be considered official from the moment they are read out by the official announcer.

A copy of the results of each event will be published in the TIC. In addition, they will be available in resultadosonline.ar of Atletismo Sudamericano and Confederación Argentina de Atletismo.

TRANSPORT

Internal transportation will be the responsibility of the organization between the hotels and the event venues.

National teams must inform their flight plans at the time of final registration, to optimize transportation logistics between the airport and hotels.

AEROPUERTOS

The city of Mar del Plata has the Astor Piazzolla Airport (**MDQ** according to IATA code), located approximately 7 kilometers from the city center.

Teams will be received at this airport and transferred to the agreed residences.

IMPORTANT:

All teams must inform their exact arrival times (means of transport, flight number and airline) and departure times before the final registration date. Without this information, the organizing committee will not be responsible for the airport/hotel/airport transfer.



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ACCREDITATION

The organization will accredit all athletes and members of the participating delegations who have been officially registered beforehand.

The documentation provided (accreditation card) must be carried for correct identification and access to technical and public areas of the venues.

Accreditation cards will be delivered at the technical meeting and - later, in case they cannot be collected at that time - they will be available at the TIC.



TECHNICAL INFORMATION

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RACE WALK

The event will be held on the officially certified (and valid) AIMS and WA road circuit.
The event will have the following characteristics and provisions:

- ◆- Lap: 1 km Appendix III - RACE WALK CERTIFICATION AND MAP
- ◆- Circuit marked with fences
- ◆- Return areas with adequate turning radii
- ◆- Directions: signs, fences and flagmen.
- ◆- Start and finish areas: wider to accommodate all teams.
- ◆- Start: athletes will be arranged in 'boxes' by teams, with the members of each team lined up in a row according to their own order..
- ◆- Refreshment and drink stations: provided by the organizer at the start, finish and each lap
- ◆- Personal hydration: special tables will be provided for each of the participating teams, where one official can stand for each athlete, always behind the table.
- ◆- Penalty zone will be established , where athletes who receive three disqualification requests (3 red cards from 3 different race walk judges) must remain for 2 minutes. If it is not possible to enter this area and the athlete inevitably reaches the finish line before being able to do so, the aforementioned time will be added to the officially recorded time.
- ◆- Upon receipt of the fourth disqualification request, they will be disqualified from the event, must withdraw from the course and remove their bib.

For timing and lap control (apart from the manual control by race judges), a system of transponders with chips located in the athletes' shoes will be used.



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RELAYS

Relay teams shall be registered by means of the corresponding forms to be presented at the TIC up to three hours before the start of each of the relay events.

The composition and final running order of the relay teams may be adjusted up to the relevant call room opening time according to the timetable of each event (WA TR 24.11).

In the case of the mixed 4x400 relays (universal), they must follow the order standardized by WA for this type of events: male - female - male - female.

Initial heights in high jump and pole vault events will be agreed at the technical meeting between all team leaders with athletes involved in these events.

After agreement, the progressions will be, unfailingly and invariably, as follows.

- o High jump : 3 cm
- o Suggested initial height for women: 1.55 mts
- o Suggested initial height men: 1.85 mts
- o Pole vault : 10 cm
- o Suggested initial height: 3.40 mts

In combined events, athletes must be present at the time indicated for the call room at the start of each day.

Then, where applicable and feasible, there will be 30 minutes of rest between the end of one event and the start of the next for each individual athlete.

A dedicated rest area will be available for the athletes concerned, where they can be assisted by up to 2 accredited team officials per athlete. Hydration and light refreshment options will be available, as well as access to toilets and physiotherapy facilities.



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JUDGES

The judging and assistant staff required to control the competitions will be proposed by Confederación Argentina de Atletismo and endorsed by Atletismo Sudamericano, through the Technical Delegate.

For combined events and relays, the scores obtained will be double counted.

The score obtained in the mixed relay will be distributed equally between the men's and women's teams.



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In addition to the score, there will be a medal table classifying the teams by gold medal, then silver and finally bronze. In the case of the mixed relay, the medal for both genders will count.

The winning athletes at the South American Championships will be considered "South American Athletics Champions".



PROTESTS

Any claim must be made verbally first to the Event's Referee by the athlete himself/herself or by his/her delegate immediately.

Appeals related to results must be submitted in writing on forms provided by the Organization, signed by the official delegate on behalf of the athlete, no more than 30 minutes after the results have been officially announced, accompanying the appeal with a US\$100 deposit or its equivalent in the national currency of the organizing country.

All appeals must be handed to the person in charge of the Technical Information Centre. The person presenting an appeal shall receive a copy containing the time of receipt.

In this case, the jury of appeal, a collegiate body, shall be convened and shall reply in writing and after examining all available evidence as soon as possible.

All protest and appeal management will be carried out in accordance with the applicable WA regulations, namely: Competition Rules No. 12, 18.5, 18.6, 18.7; Technical Rule No. 8 with all its sections.



National Records

Certificates for national record performances of the different participating countries can be requested at the technical information office.



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Medical Service

First Aid within the competition site will be located at the end of the first curve, with a team of rapid complex care and immediate extraction - if necessary - to a local hospital.

Medical services will be free of charge at the competition venue; in case of emergency, the athlete will be transferred to the city's public emergency service "Oscar Allende" General Acute Interzonal Hospital.



National teams will be responsible for using their health insurance to pay for any additional specialized services, including emergency room, consultation with a specialist physician, hospitalization, surgery, medical procedures, laboratory, x-rays, special studies and physiotherapy treatments.

Health and life insurance

Each country, according to current WA rules, is responsible for the insurance of the participants in its team. Member Federations are responsible for contracting insurance to cover illness or injury/life for members of their delegation/team when travelling internationally and must be communicated to the organization by sending a copy of the contracted medical insurance document for all members of their delegation at the time of final registration.

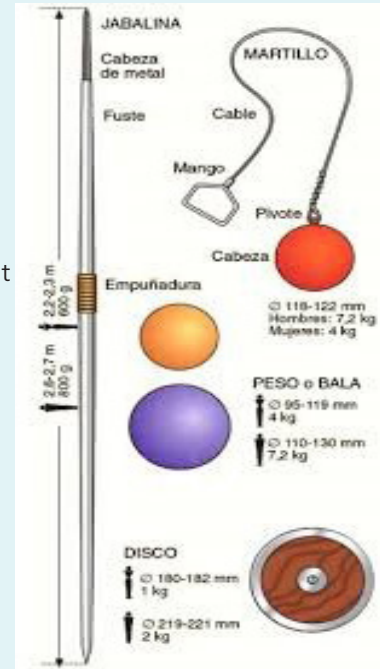


INFORMATION FOR THE ATHLETES / TEAM OFFICIALS

Sports Equipment

The organization will provide athletes with official equipment in accordance with WA regulations for all events to be held during the Championships.

The organization will authorize implements other than those of the organization as long as they are presented to the Technical Director of the event through the TIC with a (1) day prior to the start of the event, at latest at 6:00 p.m. on the previous day.



Pole Control

The poles must be presented to the Technical Directorate Two (2) hours before of the start of the event.

Training Schedules

The training sessions will be scheduled by the organization, with team leaders according to the needs and space. The schedules will be announced during the technical congress

Call Room - Timetable

Only one Call Room will be used at the exit side of the warm-up track, which is compulsory for all athletes. Combined events athletes must only report before the first event of each day.

The following controls will be carried out in the Call Room:

- ◆ Athletes identification and position in the start lists
- ◆ Bibs control
- ◆ Control of official uniforms
- ◆ Control and eventual removal of unauthorised material
- ◆ Control of competition material in accordance with WA rules, namely::

o Shoes with special reference to RT of WA n° 5, remembering that it is the responsibility of each athlete that their footwear is in accordance with the relevant competition group based on the previous control that they must carry out in the official application <https://certcheck.worldathletics.org> . There they must enter the brand and model, the system will throw up a picture of it and the set of events for which that footwear is approved. Anything that is not approved is prohibited for use, and may have effects -even- once the event is over. It is reiterated that it is the athlete's responsibility to said control.

o Number of spike positions and spike length - shoes with spikes longer than 5 mm will not be permitted , except in the high jump and javelin events, where the limit will be 7 mm. "Needle" shaped nails will not be allowed, only "pyramidal" or "tree" shaped nails will be accepted.



No team leader or officials shall be allowed in the Call Room.

The entrance to the track, jumping or throwing areas is done in an orderly manner preceding the officials and protocol guide.

Relevant presentations will be made immediately before the start of each test.

In throwing and horizontal events, athletes eliminated at the end of the qualifying rounds (3rd) will leave the competition area accompanied by an official. Similarly, athletes who finish their participation in the vertical jumps will also leave the competition area.

At the end of the competitions, athletes will leave the area in line behind the judges.

Post-competition procedures

Once the competition is over, the athletes will be led by competition assistants to the mixed zone, where the media will be located and short interviews can be given. All athletes must exit through the mixed zone.

Once they have done so, they will access the post-competition area, where they will recover their belongings and will be able to organize their departure in a comfortable and appropriate manner. If selected for doping control, a chaperone will escort them throughout the process from the exit of the competition area.

At all times, upon exiting the technical competition areas, athletes must keep in full possession of the footwear used in the competition, in case a subsequent check is required.

Technical Meeting

The technical meeting will be held on **24 April 2025 at 4:00 p.m. at TEATRO TRONADOR in Mar del Plata** (Santiago del Estero St. 1746) under the direction of the President of Atletismo Sudamericano or his representative, who together with the President of the organization, will constitute its board of directors, as well as the Atletismo Sudamericano International Technical Delegate and the Competition Director.

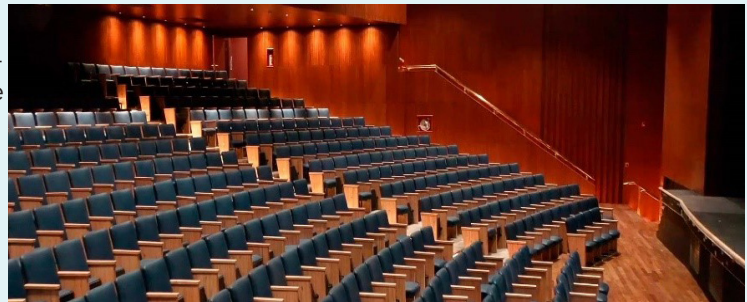


A maximum of two representatives per team may attend the meeting. It will serve exclusively to report on technical matters of the competition.

Opening Ceremony

At the same location and once the technical meeting is over, at 6:00 p.m., the official opening ceremony of the South American Championships will take place with ceremonial presence, representatives of each of the countries.

The event will be presented to the public, with a parade of national representatives, official speeches and an international presentation to the specialized press.



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JURY OF APPEAL

The Jury of Appeal of the Championship will be composed of members appointed by Atletismo Sudamericano, respecting gender and geographic equity as well as taking into account technical knowledge.



COMMISSION TO DETERMINE BEST TECHNICAL PERFORMANCE

The commission will be formed at the technical meeting, respecting gender and geographic equality as well as taking into account technical knowledge.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

It shall be conducted in accordance with the WA and WADA Doping Control Procedural Rules.

It shall be carried out by the relevant national body: the National Anti-Doping Commission. The National Anti-Doping Commission shall be in charge of both the collection of the relevant Samples and the management of the Sample results.

MATTERS NOT FORESEEN IN THE MANUAL

All matters not foreseen in this manual and which are urgent, shall be resolved by the members of the Executive Council of Atletismo Sudamericano present.

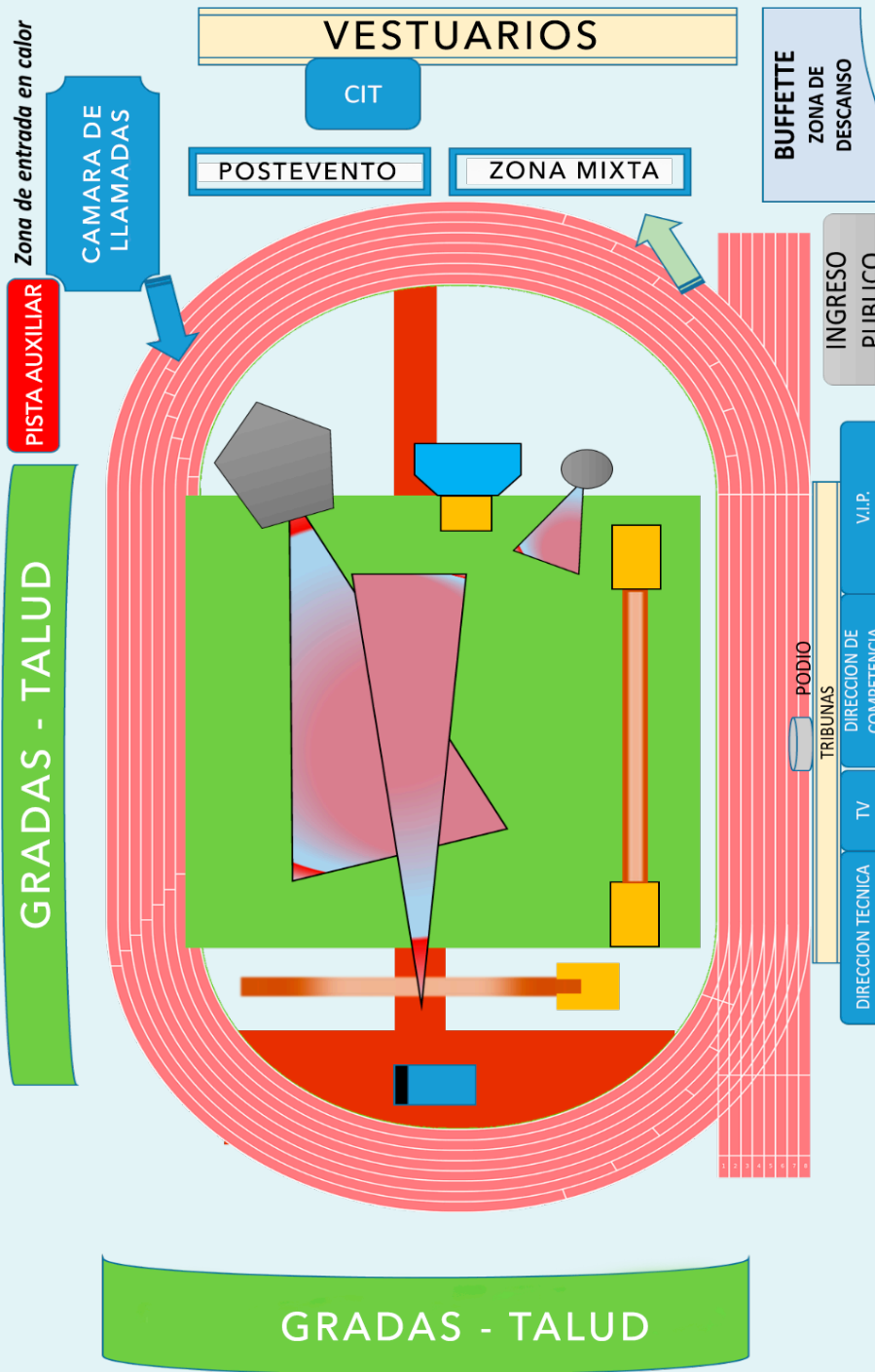
